Dear Sixth Grade Families,

On the back of this letter you will find a list of dates for the end of the year. Please review the dates and let us know if you have any questions.

June 12, 2023 is Sixth Grade Awards Night (otherwise known as 6th grade graduation). Parent volunteers are needed to ask for donations of food and drinks for refreshments, setting up and cleaning up refreshments, and volunteers are also needed to decorate. Please let us know if you are willing to help with any of these. Students will be practicing for the ceremony on the afternoon of June 12th. If possible, please don't pick up your student early on that day. During the ceremony, each student is given a Completion Certificate and two flowers to give to a parent, grandparent, or other adult who is important to them. If your student wants to give more than 2 flowers away, they will need to be purchased separately by you/ them and brought with them on the night of the 12th. The ceremony starts at 6; students should be at school no later than 5:45.

June 13 is Field Day. The events usually start at noon. Please make sure your student has a water bottle and sun screen if needed. Volunteers must be background checked. You can get more information about this from the office.

June 14 is the sixth grade end of the year trip. We will be heading to T&B's in the morning for bowling, arcade games, and lunch, then we will go to Gifford's for ice cream and mini-golf. No chaperones are needed for this trip. Everything will be paid for by the school, so students don't need to bring any money. They will be given \$10 for arcade games and can bring a little more if they want, but it is not necessary. Students can bring a water bottle, but do not need anything else.

June 15 is the last student day, and it is a half day. Students will be dismissed at 11:45. You will hear about Middle School classroom placement sometime over the summer.
